

## 2010 Razorback District Fall Cub Adventure Campout

# Pony Express

October 8, 9 & 10

**WHAT** - Cub Adventure is two nights of camping with parents, leaders and other Scouts. It is spending one day in theme activities and one evening at a campfire doing stunts, skits and songs. The event is *Pony Express*. There will be a Chuck wagon cookoff (pack interpretation...has to be made onsite), Camp Inspection, Volunteer Award, Spirit Award, Midway game and the Green campsite award. Packs are encouraged to have a themed midway game during the day on Saturday.

**WHERE** - Our Cub Adventure Campout will be in the same location as last year: 13355 Motley Rd, Bentonville, AR – between Vaughn and Centerton. Heading north on I-540, take exit 85. Turn left onto 71B, turn left onto Hwy 12, turn right on Hwy 279 north, turn left onto Motley Rd...13355 Motley Rd.

**ARRIVAL** – If you are camping Friday night, plan to arrive at the front gate between **2:00 and 9:00 PM** on Friday, October 8, 2010. Camp Staff volunteers will be waiting at the entrance to direct you to your assigned unit campsite. We will be back out Saturday morning from **7:00 – 9:30 AM**. Please unload and park vehicles and trailers as quickly as possible. **All motorized vehicles must be parked outside of the campsite area.**

### CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

1. Upon arrival, your unit representative should report to the **Headquarters Tent** to officially check-in.
2. Turn in your final unit roster of youth and adults and pay any remaining fees, if needed.
3. Pick up your Unit Campout packet with the latest information about updates and schedule. Please communicate the information with your unit.

**CRACKER BARREL** - A Leader Orientation will be held each evening at 9:00 P.M. at the headquarters tent where units will receive the schedule of events and ask questions. **We will convey information critical to your units.** All units should have a representative in attendance.

**MOWING** – Due to past campout locations, we have started letting units mow their campsite area. If you want to mow, please come Tuesday night and help with setup. As of Friday, Oct 8, there will be **NO MOWING ALLOWED** – it becomes a safety hazard. Please plan accordingly.

**CAMPFIRE** - The Saturday night activities will be done in theme. Any unit wanting to participate must register with the Campfire Coordinator, Ron Brophy, before 4:00 PM on Saturday. This will be an exciting and enjoyable time for all. A sound system will be used so that all can hear. Remind your units to bring a ground cloth, tarp, or trash bag to sit on – please limit chairs so all can see.

**RELIGIOUS SERVICES** – Sunday morning at 8:30, we will offer be an interfaith worship service near the HQ area. Bring chairs. All units are encouraged to participate. Units are welcome to conduct their own faith services if desired.

**CHECKOUT AND DEPARTURE** - Upon departing the Camporee units may check out at the Headquarters Tent or find a committee member to verify “Leave No Trace” was practiced by your unit.

**CONTESTS** – **1) Cook off contest:** Chuck wagon. The dish has to be cooked onsite and judging will be in HQ area at 17:30 (5:30pm). **2) Green Award:** we will be looking for recycling, environmentally friendly soap, rechargeable batteries, crank flashlights, etc. **3) Volunteer Award:** the volunteer hours begin on Oct. 5<sup>th</sup> when we start setting up camp. The volunteer award is figured by volunteer hours divided by number of participants by unit attending the campout. **4) Best in Theme:** Midway game?, decorations (keep the Green award in mind), subjective. **5) Spirit Award:** strictly subjective. We will be talking to activity leaders and staff members about unit’s sportsmanship, attitude, and participation. **6) Camp Inspection:** judging sheet attached at the end of this leader’s guide. **7) Midway Game:** theme related, subjective.

**ACTIVITIES:**

We will be breaking the boys up by rank for the activities. We plan to have 2 activity areas: a Tiger/Wolf/Bear area and a Webelos area.

- Shooting Sports
- Age/Rank specific activities
- Midway activities - Packs are encouraged to host a game for the midway

**IMPORTANT REMINDERS:**

- **NO PETS** – please DO NOT bring your pets to the campout
- **NO** smoking within sight of a Cub Scout
- This will be a DRY camp. Bring your own water for cooking, cleaning and drinking.
- Keep safety in mind and adhere to Boy Scout guidelines.
- Please review camp etiquette with your boys.
- No re-bar tent stakes.
- No vehicles in the camp site areas.
- No generators.
- No radios or boom boxes (except weather radios)
- No fireworks.
- No electronic games.
- No guns or sheath/large knives.
- No alcohol or illegal drugs.
- Report ALL accidents to staff immediately.
- All fires are to be contained in fireboxes to be provided by the pack.
- Port-a-potties will be provided
- **Channel 5** will be used by camp staff for two way communication. Please keep that channel clear.

### REGISTRATION FEES:

Registrations will be accepted before/on **Sept. 22nd** at a cost of \$15 per scout or \$30 per family. **Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>**, registration will be \$20 per scout or \$40 per family. Packs that want to register on/after **Oct. 2nd** will need to get special approval from the Scout Service Center, as late registrations will greatly affect campsite/event preparations.
